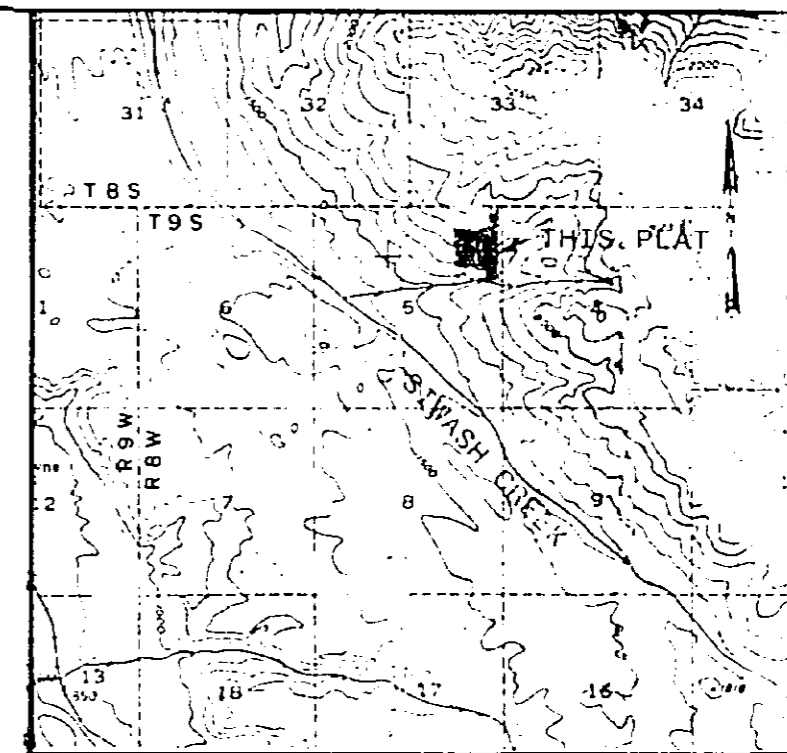
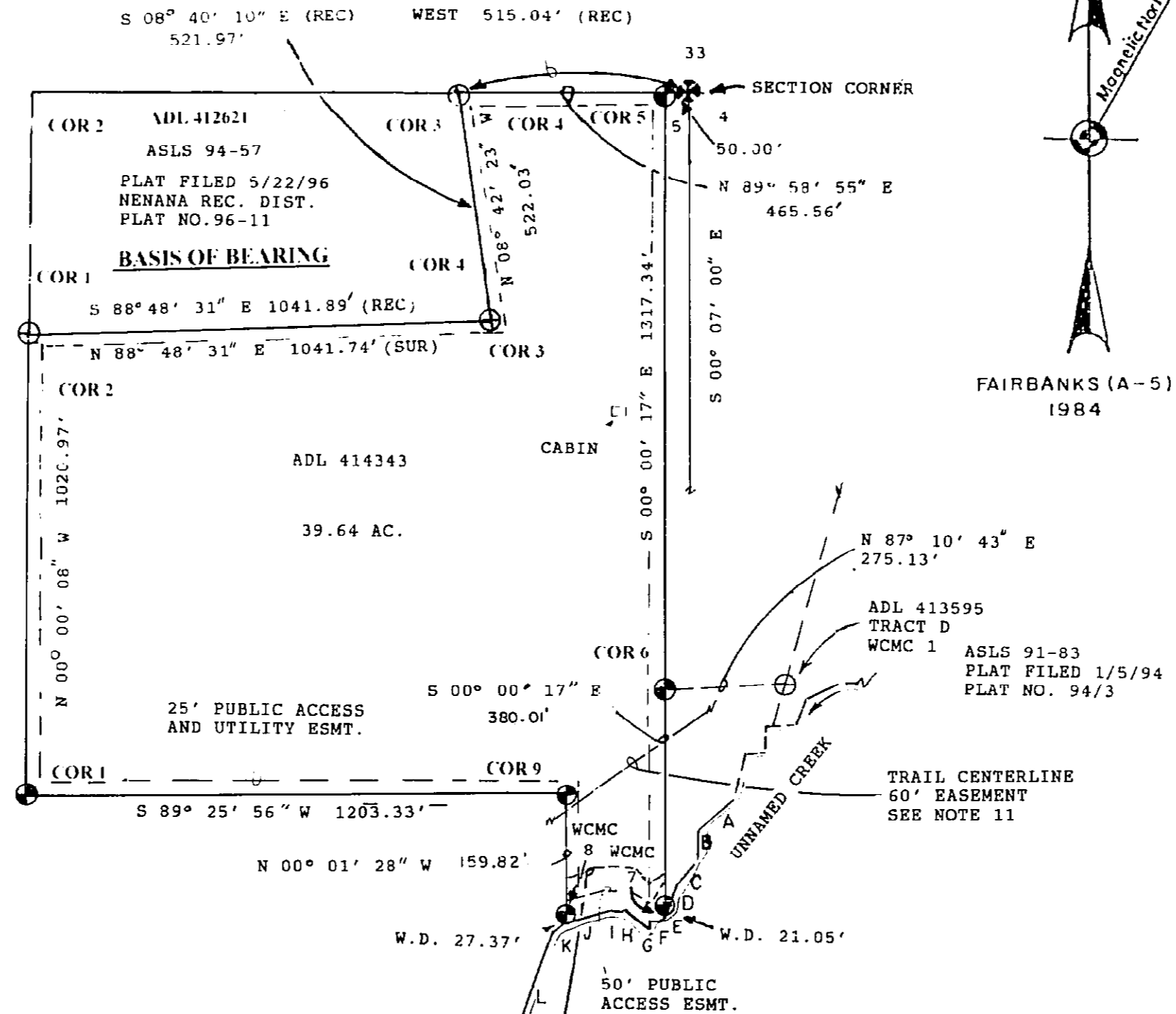


NOTES

1. SET FLANGED, MAGNETIZED ALUMINUM MONUMENT, 3-1/4" CAP, 2-3/8" O.D. PIPE, 30" LONG, BURIED 26" DEEP AND EXTENDS ABOUT 4" TO 6" ABOVE GROUND.
2. THE EXISTING CLAIMANT'S CORNERS WERE RECOVERED AND USED TO CONTROL THE LOCATION OF THE TRACT BOUNDARIES.
3. THIS SURVEY WAS ACCOMPLISHED IN ACCORDANCE WITH H-51-97-28, AND AS 38.09.010, (SLA 1983 am. 1984).
4. THE MINIMUM CLOSURE OF THE TRACT BOUNDARY AND THE MINIMUM ACCURACY OF THE FIELD SURVEYED TIE TO THE RECTANGULAR SURVEY SYSTEM, AS FIELD MONUMENTED, EXCEEDS 1:5000.
5. ALL BEARINGS SHOWN ARE TRUE BEARINGS AS ORIENTED TO THE BASIS OF BEARING, AND DISTANCES SHOWN ARE REDUCED TO HORIZONTAL FIELD DISTANCES. AVERAGE ELEVATION OF SURVEY IS APPROXIMATELY 1900 FEET ABOVE SEA LEVEL.
6. ALL PARCELS OF LANDS OWNED BY THE STATE OF ALASKA, LOCATED WITHIN FIFTY (50.00) FEET OF, OR BISECTED BY A SURVEYED SECTION LINE, ARE SUBJECT TO A FIFTY (50) FOOT EASEMENT, EACH SIDE OF THE SECTION LINE, WHICH IS RESERVED TO THE STATE OF ALASKA FOR PUBLIC HIGHWAYS UNDER A.S. 19.10.010.
7. A 25 FOOT WIDE PUBLIC ACCESS AND UTILITY EASEMENT IS RESERVED ALONG INTERIOR OF ALL LOT LINES.
8. A 50 FOOT WIDE PUBLIC ACCESS EASEMENT IS RESERVED UPLAND FROM THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK OF THE EAST FORK OF SIWASH CREEK.
9. THE NATURAL MEANDERS OF THE LINE OF ORDINARY HIGH WATER FORMS THE TRUE BOUNDS OF THE TRACT. THE APPROXIMATE LINE OF ORDINARY HIGH WATER AS SHOWN, IS FOR AREA COMPUTATIONS ONLY, WITH THE TRUE TRACT CORNERS BEING ON THE EXTENSION OF THE TRACT SIDE LINES AND THEIR INTERSECTION WITH THE NATURAL MEANDERS.
10. RECOVERED GLO MONUMENT SET IN 1917, RECTANGULAR SURVEY T.9 S., R.8 W., F.M. SURVEY APPROVED 10/09/19.
11. A 60 FOOT WIDE PUBLIC ACCESS EASEMENT, 30 FEET ALONG EACH SIDE OF THE CENTERLINE, IS RESERVED FOR EXISTING TRAIL.

VICINITY MAP

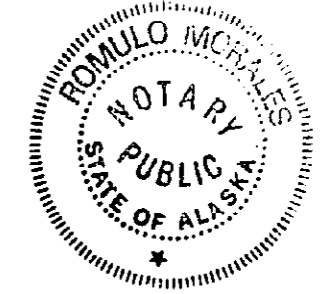

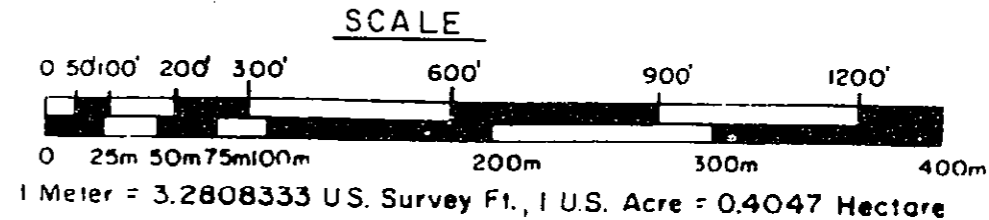

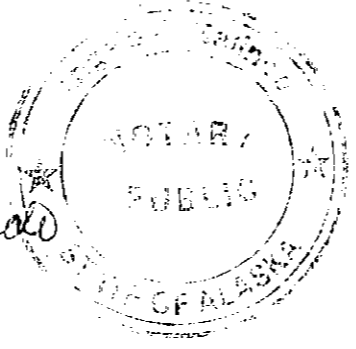
